Inquiry into Business Names (Commonwealth Powers) Bill 2011

On Wednesday, 30 November 2011 the Legislative Council referred the **Business Names (Commonwealth Powers) Bill 2011** to the Standing Committee on Uniform Legislation and Statutes Review for inquiry and report by Tuesday, 6 March 2012.

As part of its consultation, the Committee invites you to provide a written submission on:

- i) matters relating to the scope, purpose and structure of the Bill; and
- ii) matters of interpretation of the Bill as drafted, or the likely or possible extent and application of its provisions.

The text of the Bill is on the Parliamentary website www.parliament.wa.gov.au (choose Bills / Current Bills / select the Business Names (Commonwealth Powers) Bill 2011 from the alphabetical list).

The closing date for submissions is **5.00pm on Friday, 13 January 2012**. Submissions received after this date are unlikely to be considered.

Submissions are confidential until the Committee releases them. You should not disclose your submission to others until the Committee authorises its public release.

It is normal practice for the Committee to authorise the publication of submissions at tabling of the Report. Submissions are then available to the public on request. Please note that your submission may be placed on the Internet by the Committee.


