Australia now has a new national portal for product safety information, the Product Safety Australia website (www.productsafety.gov.au <file://www.productsafety.gov.au>). This website provides a single point of entry to product safety information and includes details of products subject to mandatory safety standards and bans, as well as product safety tips, myths and FAQs. Consumers and suppliers can sign up to be automatically notified via email when information in a product category they are interested in, such as children's products, is updated. The site also makes it easier for consumers and suppliers to contact the relevant consumer product safety regulator and make inquiries or complaints about potentially unsafe products.

The launch of this new website is a positive step towards the streamlining of national product safety laws. A single set of national laws will be in place from 1 January 2011.
